

Outdoor Portrait Workshop

Sunday September 27, 2009

Place: Beaver Brook Association, Hollis, NH

Goals and Objectives

The goal of this workshop is to understand and gain field experience using lighting techniques for creating outdoor portraits using natural elements to shape the light on the model. These natural elements include tree lines or forest overhangs.

Basic Equipment

The equipment needed will be your camera and a tripod (if you have one). The tripod may be needed because we will be working in deeply shaded areas with the subject being lit by open skylight. This usually requires lower shutter speeds.

We will be using lens focal lengths anywhere from 50mm (full length) to 100 mm.(head and shoulder portrait)

Optional equipment

Black or white reflectors to see the effects these will have on the natural light and environment

A low power flash may be used if lighting conditions warrant.

Directions to Beaver Brook Association

From South on NH Route 3


Head north on NH Route 3. Take Exit 6, then turn left onto Broad Street/Route 130. Drive approximately 6 miles. Bear right at the fork and travel to the set of lights in Hollis. Turn left at the lights onto Route 122 South. Drive approximately 1 mile and turn right onto Ridge Road. The Brown Lane Barn entrance is approximately .7 miles on the right. Continue .25 miles on Ridge Road to reach the Maple Hill Farm (117 Ridge Road). The Beaver Brook office is in this building.

From North on NH Route 3

Head south on NH Route 3. Take Exit 6, then turn right onto Broad Street/Route 130. Drive approximately 6 miles. Bear right at the fork and travel to the set of lights in Hollis.

Turn left at the lights onto Route 122 South. Drive approximately 1 mile and turn right onto Ridge Road. The Brown Lane Barn entrance is approximately .7 miles on the right. Continue .25 miles on Ridge Road to reach the Maple Hill Farm (117 Ridge Road). The Beaver Brook office is in this building.\
